SOLAIMANS FOUNDATION

The Solaimans foundation is a non-profit charitable [IRS tax-exempt 501 (c) 3] organization.

MISSION:

- Build facilities and impart high quality education, primary through college.
- Establish clinics and hospitals to care for the ill, especially women and children.
- Provide arsenic free drinking water.
- Help social advancement by running an orphanage in Bangladesh and providing assistance to those in need.

BACKGROUND:

The SOLAIMANS FOUNDATION today helps students go to school, provides pure drinking water, and runs a health clinic. People look towards the SOLAIMANS FOUNDATION as a model development project.

It all started in 1970. A devastating Cyclone hit the southern part of

what was then East Pakistan, now Bangladesh. Hundreds of thousands of people were washed out to sea. Village homes, made mostly of bamboo and mud, were flattened. People had nothing: no shelter and no food. It was like "Qiamat" - the apocalypse.

We, several friends and families in the Washington DC area, formed an emergency relief fund for the affected people in Noakhali, the hardest hit area. Although it was one of the most disastrous natural calamities in history, we knew it would not be the last. We recognized the need for strong, elevated structures so that people could take shelter during natural calamities. For efficient use of these structures, the same buildings could also be used as schools, health facilities, and community centers.

Who was going to implement this long-term, expensive project? Fortunately, one family came forward which picked up the discussion, planning and facilitation of the dream. Today the SOLAIMANS FOUNDATION is standing tall and has developed and assisted organizations to

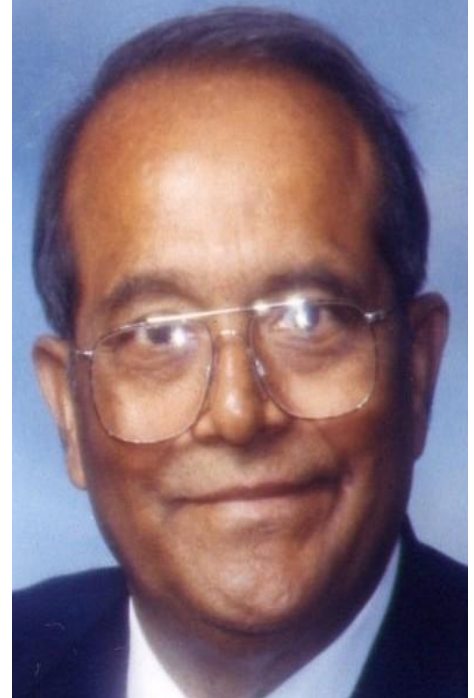
Scholarships and Humanitarian Activities

The Foundation also provides financial assistance to poor patients who need surgery, which is done in cooperation with the Bangladesh Medical College Hospital in Dhaka.

In addition, the Foundation repairs, renovates and builds homes for severely disadvantaged people. Since the inception of this program, 25 homes have been built.

SCHOOL AND COLLEGE

In 1975, the Aswadia Girls High School in Sadar, Noakhali, Bangladesh, was co-founded. The school currently enrolls over a thousand students. The government of Bangladesh presently operates the school.

In 1975, the Neazpur High School for boys was co-founded. This school is also located in Sadar, Noakhali, Bangladesh. Previously, there was no high school in this area. Now the school enrolls over a thousand students. It is currently run by the government of Bangladesh.

Bhulua Degree College

In 1994, we co-founded Bhulua Degree College in Neazpur Union, Sadar, Noakhali. This college is now government approved and hundreds of students graduate each year.

The Foundation built a 2000sft library in an area between the Neazpur High School and Bhulua Degree College in Noakhali. The concept of a library was nonexistent in rural Bangladesh. This was built with a 3-story foundation to allow for 6000 sft of space and to cater to community activities.

Sultana English School

In 2008, the Foundation established an English medium school for residential and non-residential students. Classes started in January, 2009. The building currently has 2 finished levels, each with 4,500 square feet of space. It has separate kitchen and dining facilities. A 3rd story is planned.

Mission Statement:

The mission of the Sultana English School (SES) is to seek academic excellence in young children from villages in Bangladesh. The School provides instruction in English, Science, Mathematics, Social sciences, Islamic studies and Bangla. In pursuing its mission, the School is committed to meeting the needs of a diverse student body.

HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE CENTER

In 1998 the foundation donated land, infrastructure and development cost to establish a 5-bed hospital and clinic for the care of women and children.



THE SOLAIMAN ORPHANAGE



In 2005, the Foundation established an orphanage and built accommodations and other facilities with the aims and objectives of rendering services for the benefit of poor orphans. The orphans receive care, affection, and the opportunity for self-improvement. The Foundation provides free accommodation, food, clothing and quality education. Currently 2 orphans are in high school and 2 are in Sultana English School.

Supply of Pure Drinking Water

To provide clean and arsenic, iron, and phosphate free filtered drinking water, two water filter plants were established in two villages. Adjoining villages are also receiving the benefits.



Spiritual Services

For the benefit of the community, one mosque was built in 2005.

Resources

The Solaiman family donated their family wealth in Bangladesh to the Foundation. The donations include 10 acres of ancestral farmland, 4.5 acres of parental residential property, the proceeds of two houses in Dhaka, a sizeable amount of Uttara Bank shares, and a sizeable amount of cash from the USA.

Resources Needed

The Foundation currently needs to complete the third story of the Sultana English School building; construct a play ground; purchase some land currently under negotiation; purchase a school bus; purchase computers for each classroom, a computer lab, and a science lab; purchase shelves and books for the library; and purchase furniture for classrooms.

The estimated amount to accomplish these objectives is between \$200,000 to \$300,000 (Tk 14,000,000 to Tk 21,000,000). The recurring expenses are estimated to be \$50,000 to \$60,000 (Tk 350,000 to Tk 400,000) per month. We have received pledges of about Tk 50,000 per month.
